

Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on packaging and packaging waste (PPWR)

The objective of the Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on packaging and packaging waste, **PPWR**, is to minimize the environmental impact of packaging and to strengthen the circular economy. It establishes uniform and binding requirements across the European Union for the **design, labelling, and circularity of packaging**.

We are fully aware of the requirements given and constantly monitor the further development of the regulation, its concretization and implementation. We are now in the process of analyzing and assessing these requirements carefully.

As of August 2026, packaging will have to comply with **Article 5** of the regulation regarding **substance minimization**.

To the best of our knowledge and based on the information from our packaging suppliers the packaging of our products does not exceed the maximum value of 100 ppm of the sum of lead, cadmium, mercury and hexavalent chromium as required by Artikel 5 of the Packaging Waste Regulation (EU) 2025/40 (PPWR), repealing EU Directives 94/62/EEC (Packaging Directive). As our products are plastic granules, the requirements concerning per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) as defined by Regulation (EU) 2025/40 for packaging coming into contact with food are not applicable.

We plan further adjustments to our packaging regarding recyclability, reducing material diversity, avoiding oversized packaging, increasing the use of mono-materials and separable combinations as well as developing reusable packaging systems.

Please be informed, that the EU declaration of conformity for each unique packaging item and evidence demonstrating compliance through formal technical data, see Article 39, is now developed and will be kept by us accordingly to be shown to authorities. The regulation does not require to send out these documents to customers.
